Dr. Jack D. Kinneer is the Director of the Doctor of Ministry Program, and Adjunct Professor of Biblical Studies, in the Reformed Presbyterian Theological Seminary in Pittsburgh, PA. Dr. Kinneer teaches Elementary Greek, New Testament Exegesis, and New Testament classes such as Romans and Revelation. He is founder and Scholar in Residence at Echo Hills Christian Study Center in Indian Head, PA, which exists to provide educational services to deepen and enrich the understanding of the Christian faith. He also has been interviewed on behalf of RPTS with media nationally on the veracity of the Bible. A minister of the Presbyterian Church in America, Dr. Kinneer is the author of *How to Grow in Christ*, and contributing writer to *Order in the Offices: Essays Defining the Roles of Church Offices*.

Tim Bayly has served as senior pastor at ClearNote Church (CNB) since 1996. From 1996-2000, he was also Executive Director of the Council on Biblical Manhood and Womanhood. # WHY A CONFERENCE ON MAN BEING CREATED IN THE IMAGE OF GOD?

## 1: Life is not considered sacred in our culture anymore.

Every new life begins at conception. Our culture no longer argues that abortion does not end a life. Rather people now argue one life is more important than another. On January 22nd, 2013, the United States celebrated the anniversary of the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision. Since 1973, there have been approximately 55,772,015 abortions in the land of the free.

## 2: Morality is now defined by popular opinion, not God's Holy Word.

Since 2009, fourteen states have now legalized same-sex marriage. In 1977 only 13% of the public supported gay marriage. By 2010 that number had grown to almost 50%. Has God's Word changed on this issue, or have we changed our position regarding the Word of God?

## 3. Does separation of Church & State mean the Church has no role in the culture?

Distinguished Presbyterian theologian James H. Thornwell wrote: "The religion of the State is embodied in its Constitution, as the concrete form of its organic life. The separation of Church and State is a very different thing from the separation of religion and the State. We must contemplate people and rulers as alike subject to the authority of God. His will is the true supreme. To the extent that the State is a moral person, it must needs be under moral obligation, and moral obligation without reference to a superior will is a flat contradiction in terms." In our day and age, there is a constant effort to erase any mention of the God of the Bible from our local, state, and national arenas of life. Join us as we examine God's Word concerning the role of the Church and what our response should be to an ever-increasing secular culture.
